## **Uniforms**

Payments for school shirts, spirit shirts, and Chromebook insurance are all available on MY PAYMENTS PLUS on our website. All students are still expected to wear uniforms to school.

**Masks are required, but must meet school system requirements in that they are school appropriate - No bandana print or anything written that would be inappropriate or distracting. At this time gaiters and handkerchiefs are allowed, but the Louisiana Department of Health is currently reviewing their effectiveness, so their use may be banned.**

Students will not dress out for PE until at least Phase 3; **PE uniforms** are not required at this time but are available for purchase through MY PAYMENTS PLUS on our website for use later in the year.

### **Hybrid Schedule/ Phase 2 quick facts for Folsom Junior High:**

- Students in grades 6-12 will follow a hybrid schedule for Phase 2.
- Students will be split into two groups and physically attend school on alternating days.
- Students with the first letter in their last name beginning with A-K will physically attend school on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- Students with the first letter in their last name with L-Z will physically attend school on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- Groups will alternate attending in person on Fridays.
- When not physically present in the school building, students will participate in required distance learning and attendance will be taken daily.
- Students' needs will be assessed to identify any student who may require more in-person instruction than scheduled, including special education students, 504 students, English Learners.
- Employees will work five days a week in person unless otherwise notified.
- Siblings will attend school in person on the same days. PLEASE let us know if you have multiple students in your household with different last names.
- Lunch counts will be taken daily and emailed to the cafeteria by 7:45am  
More information on grab and go lunches will be available on the [www.stpsb.org](http://www.stpsb.org) website.
- Car line will run as it normally does. Please pull all the way to the end of the sidewalk in front of the cafeteria. We will post signs in order to ensure students are socially distanced.
- Temperature screening will take place upon arrival in the classroom.
- Teachers will be on duty directing students at 7am.
- Breakfast will be served grab and go style.
- Lunches will be served in small groups in accordance with the guidelines in the cafeteria.
- If you are checking your child out please call ahead or from your car, we will call your student and so they are on their way to the office and we will have the card ready for your signature.
- There are no visitors on campus for any reason who are non-essential.
- Please be sure we have an accurate cell phone number so we can send robo text messages. This is not possible if every child does not have a parent's cell phone in JPAMS.
