Hello. This is Amy Barrow, principal of Folsom Jr. High. I want to give you an update about our school system's plans as the state moves into Phase 3. We are awaiting details and further guidance to determine how we will safely transition to the next phase of our school attendance plan. This will take time and will not happen immediately. We will continue with the plan we currently have in place where beginning Monday, September 14, students in grades Pre-K to 5 return to in-person five days a week, and students in grades 6-12 follow the hybrid model. We will continue to follow health and safety protocols that are in place. We will provide an update and more information Friday, September 18. Thanks for your patience and support as we work together for a safe and successful beginning to this school year.

As a reminder, beginning of the year paperwork was sent home with your child. Please make sure to turn in the Chromebook User Agreement as soon as possible. Chromebooks cannot be issued to the student without the agreement on file. The insurance must be paid for by October 1<sup>st</sup>. This is a very good investment because accidents happen and the most inexpensive part of the Chromebook is more than \$30.
